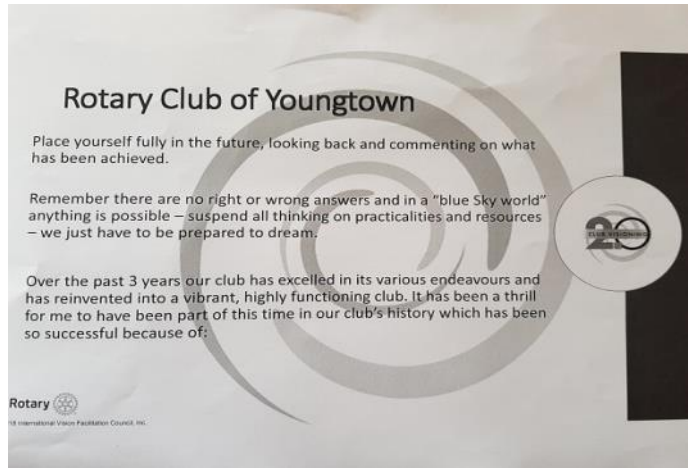
The Manage tab shows reports from other clubs. Take Action site is also very helpful in developing projects. Take the time to have a browse.
