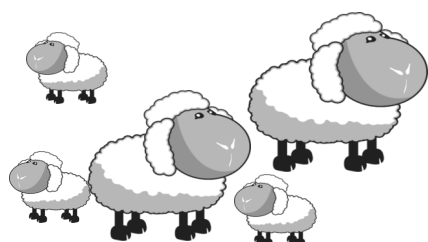


### It's that time again!!!!
