### Ribbons of Reflection Day 1st Sep 2023

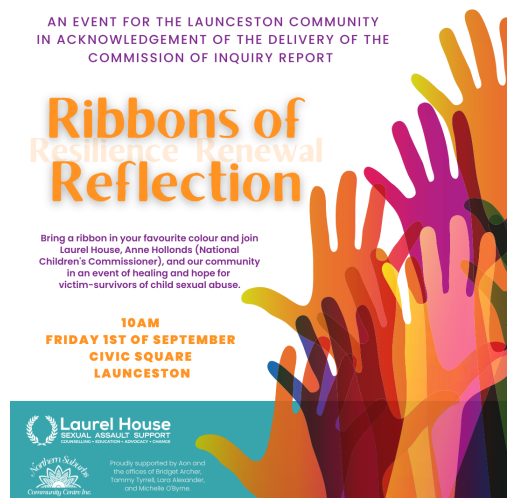
The Commission of Inquiry into Tasmanian Government Responses to Institutional Child Sexual Abuse will hand their report to the Governor on the 31 August and will be tabled in Parliament and released to the public by the 28<sup>th</sup> September.

While the work of the Commission has been critical, it has been a challenging time for victim-survivors and their supporters. Laurel House and members of our community have come together to hold an event to mark the end of the Commission of Inquiry and to provide an opportunity for the community to recognise the resilience of victim-survivors and to reflect on the role that every member of the community, and especially our Government, needs to play in preventing and responding to child sexual abuse.

Bring a ribbon in your favourite colour and join Laurel House, Anne Hollonds (National Children's Commissioner), and our community in an event of healing and hope for victim-survivors of child sexual abuse.

The event will include speeches from Anne Hollonds (National Children's Commissioner) and two survivor-advocates and will invite community members to show their support for victim-survivors and the prevention of child sexual abuse.
